A fun project for parents/guardians and children to work together to learn more about your family, while collaborating with school to share your family traditions.




Option 1: Family Recipe

Choose a favourite family recipe and write it up to be displayed. You may wish to share the history of the recipe, why you love it, and maybe even provide a sample for guests to taste.




Option 2: Family Legend
