Tuesday, May 27th at the SCCHS track in Swift Current

Running, jumping, and throwing events will begin at **9:30 A.M.**

The staff has appreciated the help of parents at past meets, and once again, we would appreciate the assistance of a few **parent volunteers** for each group leader. If you are interested in helping out, please phone the school to make arrangements by Tuesday, May 20th. This year we will also be bringing the Grade 7 & 8 students to help at each station.

Students will compete at their own grade level. For grades 1 & 2, the students will receive 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place ribbons as well as ribbons of participation. In grades 3 & 4, and 5 & 6, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place ribbons will be distributed.

The students in grades 4 – 6 who qualify in the top 3 of their age group at our local track meet will also have the opportunity to participate in the Highway Track Meet, competing against students from Herbert, Success/Stewart Valley, Hodgeville, and Vanguard on Thursday, May 29th. The Highway Track Meet will be held at the SCCHS track.

Students will compete in some events prior to the track and field day. Eliminations for high jump will take place ahead of time. The top jumpers from each group will compete at the track meet.

It is important on track and field day for each student to have the opportunity to do his/her best and also to enjoy the day. The enjoyment of this day is largely dependent upon student's participation and co-operation. With that in mind, students are still expected to adhere to the rules of our school. We are confident that this will occur and that the well-being of those involved will remain important.

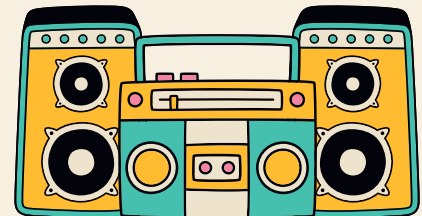

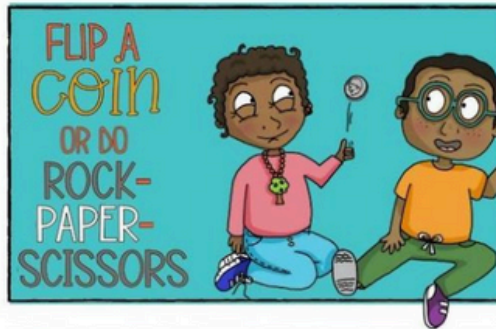
