

The students visited the Science Centre and watched an Imax movie, mini-golfed and mined for some gems, swam at the hotel pool, and created pottery bobble heads in their pottery class. They were excellent ambassadors for our schools!

Athletes attended two meets - Gull Lake Bantam Invitational Twilight Meet on May 13th, and the SWAC Bantam District Meet held at SCCHS on May 21. The meet in Gull Lake was a great for us since the majority of our team had never been to a middle years track meet before. Our athletes got a good sense of what to expect before the bigger meet at SCCHS. That was a good meet for us too! Many of our athletes performed quite well and placed in the top three. We also had a few athletes make the top aggregate standings, which are points accumulated for their standings in all their events. Here are some of the results:
