

Waldeck School Kindergarten Supply List 2024/2025

- 1 backpack with zipper closure
- 1 lunch kit - student able to open themselves
- Water bottle - preferably spill proof with flip up straw
- Non-marking running shoes for indoor use (velcro/slip-on if cannot tie yet)
- 1 plastic pencil box (this makes it easy to see their markers/pencil crayons)
- 6-8 HB pencils
- 2 erasers
- 2 packs of washable markers
- 1 pack coloured pencils
- 1 pack crayons
- 1 ruler
- 1 kids blunt tip scissors
- 3 large glue sticks
- 3 white liquid glue bottle
- 1 package of SLIM dry erase markers (slim, any color, any brand, min 5)
- 4 duotangs (any colour)
- 2 Hilroy notebooks (light blue - with full blank pages)
- 2 Hilroy notebook (green - with $\frac{1}{2}$ blank $\frac{1}{2}$ interlined pages)
- 2 small notepads
- 1 1" binder, any colour, but must be a "view" binder (have a clear cover to insert a title page)
- 1 package of 3 ring binder page protectors (10-25 count)
- 1 box of Ziploc large freezer bags
- 1 box of sandwich size Ziploc bags
- 1-2 Large box of tissues (ex. kleenex)
- 1 container of sanitizing wipes
- 1 pair of headphones (not bluetooth, labelled with name)
- 1 painting shirt (old windbreaker jacket works well - something water repellant)
- 1-3 4x6 family photo (will be kept at school all year)
- 1 set of spare clothes that are 1 size larger than current size (socks, pants, underwear, and shirt) in a plastic bag marked with your child's name. This will stay at school all year. If your child uses their spare clothes throughout the year, please send another set of spare clothes back to school ASAP.
- Optional - Hand Sanitizer (pump style)
- Please put your child's name on their backpack, lunch kit, binders, duotangs, notebooks, scrapbook, shoes, headphones, and spare clothes. Please label your child's outdoor clothing, including shoes/boots. We share all other supplies, so they do not need to be labeled and will not be returned at the end of the year. Do not empty supplies into pencil case as this will be done in class.
- I will be making new and exciting sensory bins throughout the year. Some months it may be play doh, slime, sand doh, water beads, etc. If you are able to donate any of the following items it would be greatly appreciated by myself and the students: corn starch, flour, cream of tartar, food colouring, time, etc.
